#### **Procedure to Install Moser Baer Token and Certificate Generation**

#### **1. Installation of Moser Baer Token Driver**

- > Installation of the driver has to be done for the first time and only once.
- > In the pop-up-menu click **<u>Smart Card/ USB eToken Driver</u>**
- Download the driver from http://nicca.nic.in/html/datakey.html for Moser Baer e-Token, from option no. 11.
- Click Save
- Unzip the downloaded file. It contains installation instruction. Go to the Drivers 32 and 64 bit (Windows).
- There are two .exe files (i) SafeSign-IClient-3.0.45x32.rar and (ii) SafeSign-IClient-3.0.45x64.rar.

One is for 32 bit operating System and other for 64 bit operating system.

Install appropriate SafeSign-Identity-client as per your operating system.

The installation procedure is in Quick Reference Guide available.

- Click on Next button when prompted.
- > On completion of the installation, click on the **Finish** button.

## 2. Download and Install Certificate Chain

To download and Install certificate chain follow these steps.

- > Open the Browser and go to <u>https://nicca.nic.in</u>
- ▶ In the pop up menu Click on "Certificate Chain"
- Click Save
- ➢ Unzip the downloaded file. It contains 8 certificates.

## i. Double Click on CCA India 2011.cer:

(a)Click on Install Certificate
(b)Click on Next
(c)Click on Next Under Certificate Store
(d)Click Finish
(e)The import was successful message displayed
(f)Click Ok

## ii. Double Click on CCA INDIA 2014.cer

## iii. Double Click CSCA India.cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above

iv. Double Click NIC CA 2011.cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above

v. Double Click NIC CA 2014.cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above

vi. Double Click NIC Sub CA 2014.cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above

vii. Double Click NIC sub-CA for ePassport-India 2011.cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above

## viii. Double Click NIC sub-CA for NIC 2011.Cer

Follow the instructions (a) to (f) as above Ok

# **3. Browser Settings**

Active-X controls need to be enabled in your Internet browser. In order to ensure this, please do the following:

- Open a browser window
- ➢ Go to Tools >> Internet Options >> Security
- Click 'Custom Level' and set security level as 'Medium' and enable all Active-X controls
